#### A SET OF HEADPHONES


Through the headphones, the walkers heard information about the different locations where the performances took place, as well as different spots we walked by. Throughout the walk we visited the following 6 locations: The Poortgebouw, a neighborhood building in the Stieltjesstraat (in front of the Maas), the Hef Park, the Koninginnebrug, the Koozie cafe and Tante Nino.

From their headphones, the walkers got information such as the history of the buildings, recorded and live interviews with the neighbours and facts about the projects and initiatives which take place in the neighborhood.




#### A MAP OF THE ROUTE

Complementing the headphones, the walkers also got a map that they could take home with them. The front side of the map showed the walkers the route that they visited in the neighborhood.


